Looking after each other.

We encourage all Conference attendees to undertake a COVID-19 test the evening before attending Conference for the first time and again 48 hours later.

For our international guests:

- free RAT Kits are available at the airport. Please collect as many as you need before you leave the terminal.
- if your RAT is positive, we encourage you to also get a PCR test to help New Zealand monitor new COVID-19 variants. PCR tests are free, so make sure to tell them you are a recent international arrival. You can find out more about getting a PCR test [here](#)

Self-isolation rules in New Zealand

If your RAT is positive, you are required to [self-isolate](#) for 7 days.

NZ Citizens

- you cannot take a commercial flight, interisland ferry or use public transport to return home to self-isolate
- you cannot do any long distance trips that require an overnight stay in order to return home to self-isolate
- if you cannot safely drive home in a single journey you will need to self-isolate where you are. Please consider that you may feel too unwell to drive.
- if you regularly take medication, ensure you have a 7 day supply with you as a minimum

International guests:

- you must self-isolate where you are
- you may leave your self-isolation in order to [get a PCR test](#), but otherwise you must not leave your accommodation for the full seven days.
- Hotel room service, [uber eats](#) or takeaway deliveries are available (check with the supplier first) depending on where you are staying
